Day 1: Oslo's Electric Welcome

You arrive in Oslo and immediately feel the city's hip energy. After settling into your hotel, you take a stroll through the lively streets, soaking in the atmosphere of this Scandinavian capital. Day 2: Alta Arrival: Reindeer, Sami & Lodge

The day begins with breakfast and a scenic, pleasant flight to Alta, where the land-scape shifts dramatically to the Arctic wilderness. We meet a Sami reindeer herder who introduces us to these gentle creatures, allowing you to feed them and learn about the traditions of the Sami people. Warming up around a bonfire, sipping coffee, and tasting local Siida cake feels like an authentic immersion into Arctic life. Afterward, we settle into our wilderness lodge, greeted with stunning views of the river. The evening ends with a Nordic-inspired dinner, and you feel completely at peace in this remote, very northern paradise.

Day 3: Hunting for Crab & Auroras

The afternoon is yours to unwind in the sauna or jacuzzi. As the evening falls, excitement builds as we head out on a Northern Lights hunt. The anticipation is high, and your guide shares insights about this magical natural phenomenon. As we search for the perfect view, you can't help but hope to catch a glimpse of the elusive Aurora Borealis.

Day 4: Husky Ride to Paradise

This is what Finnmark is all about! Afterward, we bid farewell to Alta and fly to the Lofoten Islands, with a stop in Tromsø for a memorable dinner. As we arrive at the lodge nestled between the mountains and the sea, you feel a sense of awe at the rugged beauty of Lofoten. You are staring at Norway's most famous postcard, but life-sized! The cozy, luxurious cabin is the perfect retreat, and you look forward to exploring the wild landscapes in the days ahead. Dinner comes with gourmet food, laughter and friendships forming.

The evening is quiet and relaxed, with time to enjoy the lodge's amenities or explore the village. You feel connected to both the past and present of this beautiful land, and the night ends with a sense of contentment and delicious, amazing local dishes.

As you capture the aurora on camera, it feels like you've truly experienced the magic of the Arctic.

A stop at Ramberg Beach and a visit to the unique village of Å (yes, it is called "Å") provide the perfect end to the day's explorations. Back at the lodge, we gather for an out-of-this-world celebratory dinner, toasting to the beauty of Lofoten and the unforgettable memories we've made along the way. You feel incredible about this adventure.


