

Journey Itinerary



Day 1: Welcome to Zermatt

You arrive in Zermatt and check into the charming Chalet Hotel Schönegg. The adventure begins with a warm welcome dinner, where you meet your Tour Director and fellow travelers. The Matterhorn looms in the background as you raise a glass to the journey ahead. Conversations flow easily, excitement builds, and you begin to feel at home in this Swiss alpine paradise. The crisp mountain air and stunning views set the tone for an unforgettable trip. As you settle in, the realization sinks in: you are finally here, ready to explore Switzerland in all its glory.

Day 2: Gornergrat and Zermatt Exploration

The Matterhorn stands proudly, its silhouette iconic against the sky. We pause for lunch at Riffelhaus 1853, savoring a meal with a view that belongs on a postcard. Returning to Zermatt, the afternoon is free for you to explore. Stroll through the charming streets, browse quaint shops, or simply breathe in the fresh alpine air. As the sun sets, the magic of the mountains lingers in your mind.

Day 3: Scenic Trains and Lake Maggiore

The morning begins with a train ride from Zermatt to Brig. We take a stroll through the old town, marveling at Stockalper Castle's imposing presence. After a delightful lunch, we continue our journey by train to Domodossola, then board the Centovalli scenic train. The landscape shifts—deep gorges, waterfalls, and picturesque villages blur past the windows. We cross into the Italian-speaking region of Switzerland, arriving in Locarno on the shores of Lake Maggiore. It feels like stepping into a different world, where mountains meet Mediterranean charm.

A short train ride takes us to Paradiso, where we board a funicular up San Salvatore, Lugano's home mountain. From the top, the views stretch for miles—Lake Lugano sparkles below, framed by dramatic peaks. We take a scenic hike, soaking in the breathtaking surroundings. Lunch is served at the Vetta Restaurant, where the panoramic veranda provides the perfect backdrop. With full stomachs and happy hearts, we descend by funicular and train back to Locarno. The day's blend of nature, adventure, and relaxation is exactly what makes Switzerland so special.

Lunch on board makes the experience even more indulgent. We dock in Lucerne, where the historic Hotel Schweizerhof welcomes us. The day has been one of seamless, breathtaking transitions—from rail to water, from south to central Switzerland, all in effortless elegance.


Day 8: Departure or Further Exploration


