

## Iceland's Beautiful Land & People



## Day 1: Southern Charm

Today your Icelandic vacation starts. You are excited about discovering an Iceland that is often overlooked by tourists. As you and your co-travelers meet, you see that everyone shares in the excitement. Our tour director gives us a taste of what's to come and we leave Reykjavik, due south. Throughout the day we marvel at all the famous waterfalls and black-sand beaches in the south coast, but we continue eastward. Let's celebrate, together, a wonderful first day of much happiness with a delicious kick-off dinner!

## Day 2: Zipping Through Icebergs

You wake up well rested, feeling the peace and tranquility surrounding our hotel. "I'm in Iceland!" is your first thought. After breakfast we jump in a Zodiac boat tour and zip through the mirror-like waters of the Glacier Lagoon. Our jaws drop at the sight of a huge glacier just a hundred feet away. Icebergs, seals and local birds move freely around us. Later we walk the sands of Diamond Beach: large ice blocks sitting on black sand, reflecting the sunlight. In the afternoon we arrive in Hofn, a fishing village founded in 1897. That's our home for the next 2 nights. On a walking tour we learn about the village and taste local delicacies along the way.

## Day 3: One Foot on a Volcano, Another on a Glacier

Day 3 of our vacation is enjoyed at a UNESCO world heritage site, Vatnajökull National Park. We have an infinity of landscapes to explore at this place. It is one of Nature's works of art shaped by the dynamic forces of volcanoes and glaciers. Later, we share food and stories in an historic building with wooden floorboards, colorful artwork, and dimly lit candles. Everything in the restaurant is prepared from scratch and done by hand, using quality ingredients. You can feel and taste the authenticity. All very Icelandic.

## Day 4: If a Tree Falls in Iceland, Does It Make a Sound?

Another outstanding breakfast and we head out, getting deeper into Iceland's east fjords region. That is also home to the country's only forest. In east Iceland we find a strong focus on nature conservation, original local art and much Icelandic hospitality. We will spend 2 nights in Egilsstaðir and experience outdoor hot tubs, incomparable views and the best of Icelandic food. Tranquility, cultural enrichment and adventure, all in one place for us to absorb.

## Day 5: A Canyon, a Farm and Puffins – Find the Connection!

It is Day 5 and you feel fantastic about everything. Let's get deeper into the essence of Iceland. Starting with geology, we explore a majestic canyon. It reveals towering basalt rock columns and a stunning blue-green glacial river. The area around it was inhabited only by sheep for a long time. Then, we meet the owners of a local, organic farm, tour their facilities and taste made-from-scratch dishes. Finally, we discover Seydisfjordur, a small village up north. You lose track of time as you stroll around the town's center, admiring the early 19th-century timber houses. Not far away, awaiting our visit, are rocky beaches, a puffin colony and ruins with stories to tell.

## Day 6: Walking on the Moon

In the north of Iceland we find the Lake Myvatn region, home to mind-bending geological features. We see craters, lava fields, and hot springs. The sites tell a story of the raw natural forces that shaped Iceland's unique landscape. We explore this lunar landscape, full of surprises, then take a dip in a geothermal pool with a unique blend of minerals. Good for the skin, good for the soul. After a full day we arrive at our fjord-side hotel surrounded by mountains. Time to reflect on the day, eat, and rest.


## Day 8: Have Your Ice Cream and Eat It Too




