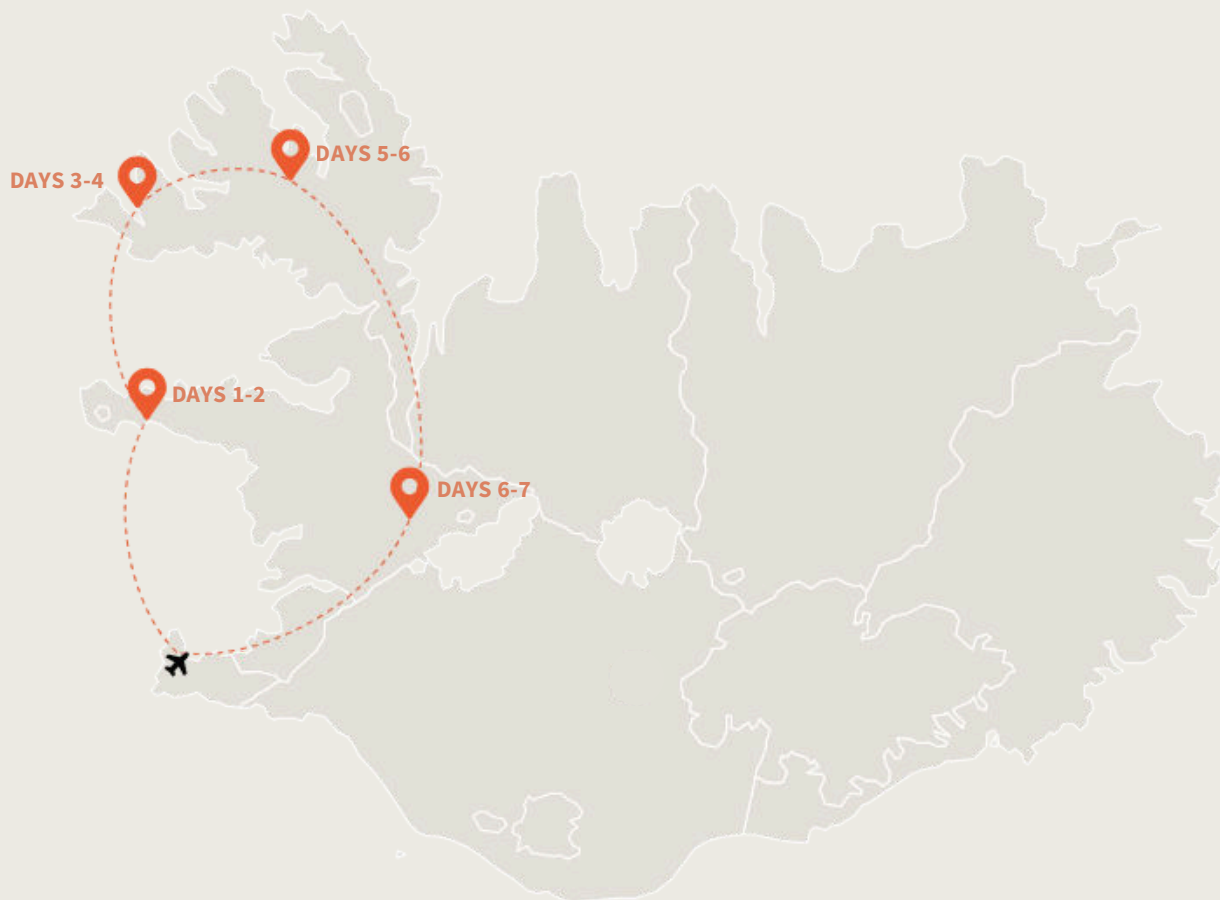

Take in your surroundings with lunch, and let's continue toward the Westfjords, Iceland's most sparsely populated region.

At the magnificent Látrabjarg bird cliffs, we’ll find millions of seabirds, including razorbills, guillemots, northern gannets, and puffins. It is also Iceland’s westernmost point. And while most people have heard of the black-sand beaches in Iceland, we will actually walk on red sand at stunning Rauðasandur beach, which derives its name, as you probably guessed, from the sand itself. Yes, “wow” is right (again)!

We reach today’s destination: Heydalur, where we are welcomed by our hosts, cozy accommodations, untouched nature, and meals composed of local ingredients. It’s like home... but in Iceland.

Fulfilled, we arrive at Hotel Húsafell, a place of serene luxury, just in time for dinner.

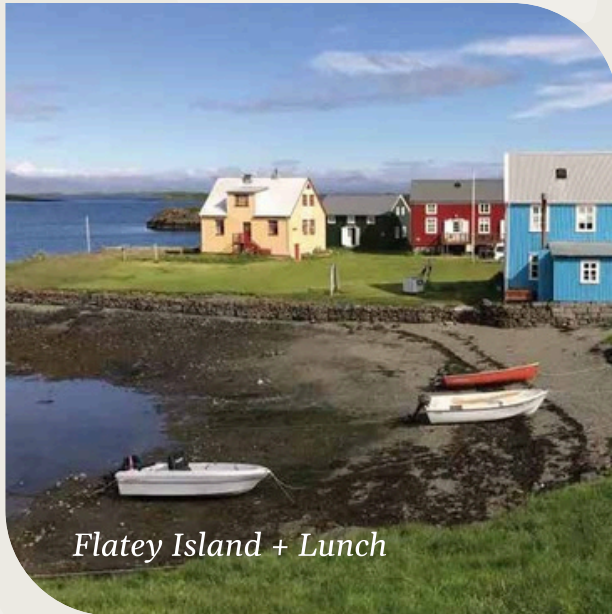

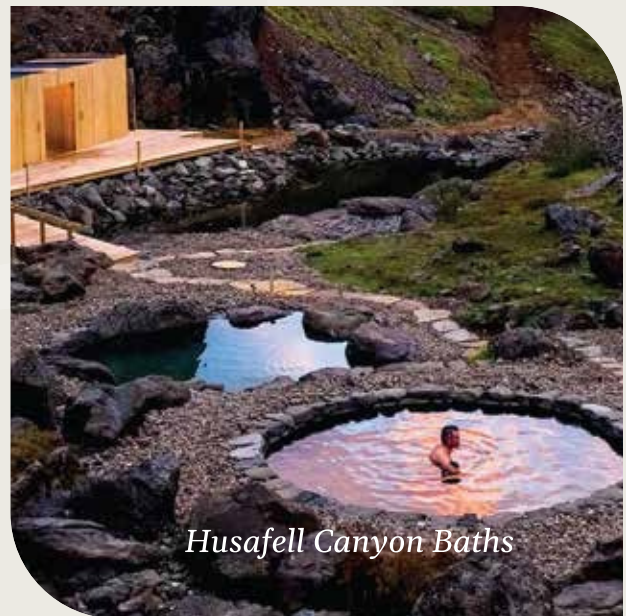

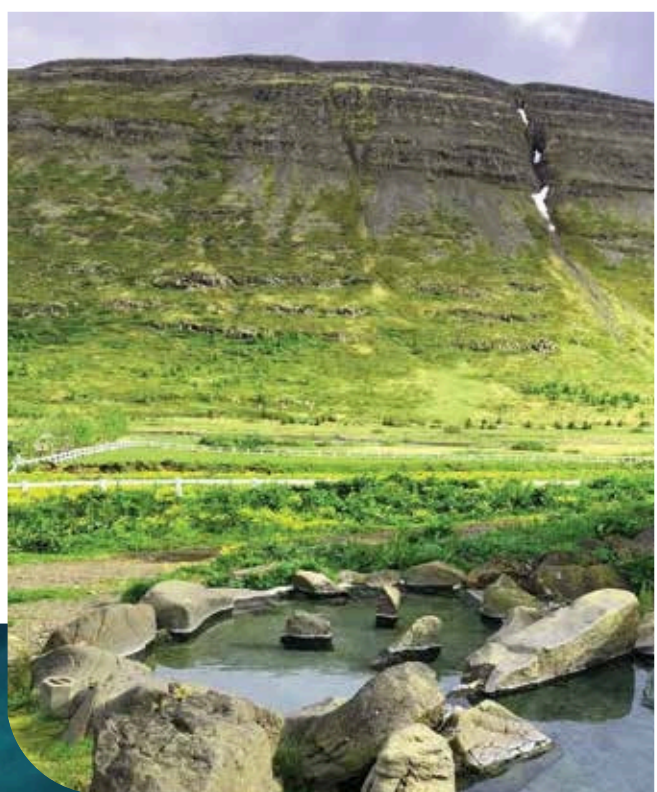
