

Black Sands and Dinner Plans

Day 1: Southern Charm

Today, your Icelandic adventure begins, and you can feel the excitement building. As you meet your fellow travelers, there's a shared energy—everyone eager to discover a side of Iceland few ever see. Iceberg Tango and Village Vibes

Day 2: Zipping Through Icebergs

You wake feeling rested, surrounded by the quiet beauty of the southeast. After breakfast, we board a Zodiac boat and glide through the still waters of the Glacier Lagoon. Icebergs drift past, seals swim nearby, and a massive glacier looms just ahead—you're speechless. Later, we walk along Diamond Beach, where chunks of ice sparkle like gems on black sand. In the afternoon, we arrive in Höfn, a fishing village by the sea. On a walking tour, we learn its story, meet locals, and sample fresh seafood. Tonight, it feels good to call this little town home.

Day 3: One Foot on a Volcano, Another on a Glacier

Adventure awaits in Vatnajökull National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site carved by glaciers and shaped by volcanic power. The landscapes feel infinite—ice, ash, mountains, and silence. You pause often, taking it all in, each view more dramatic than the last. As evening falls, we gather for dinner at a local restaurant with a fresh, creative spirit. Everything is made from scratch, ensuring a truly unforgettable dining experience.

Day 4: Iceland's East: Wild and Rooted

After breakfast, we head into Iceland's wild east, beginning at Stokksnes Peninsula, where black dunes and the sharp peaks of Vestrahorn rise against the sky. Next, we visit Djúpivogur, a quiet coastal village known for its art and slow-living philosophy. You wander past sculptures and sea views, feeling the pace of life shift. Lunch is at a charming organic farm where everything is fresh, homemade, and full of flavor. Later, we reach Egilsstaðir, our base for two nights. Surrounded by forest and fjords, you soak in a hot tub and breathe in the stillness.

Day 5: Echoes of the East Fjords

We begin the day at a majestic canyon, where soaring basalt cliffs frame a blue-green glacial river below. The landscape is untouched, once roamed only by sheep, and now it stirs something deep in you. In the afternoon, arrive in Seyðisfjörður, a colorful village tucked between mountains and sea. You lose track of time as you stroll around the town's center, admiring the early 19th-century timber houses. Not far away, awaiting our visit, are rocky beaches, a puffin colony, and ruins with stories to tell.

Day 6: Geology Unleashed in Mývatn

In the north of Iceland, we find the Lake Myvatn region, home to mind-bending geological features. We see craters, lava fields, and hot springs. The sites tell a story of the raw natural forces that shaped Iceland's unique landscape. We explore this lunar landscape, full of surprises, then take a dip in a geothermal pool with a unique blend of minerals. Good for the skin, good for the soul. After a full day, we arrive at our fjord-side hotel with time to reflect on the day, eat, and rest.

Day 8: Sweet Farewell from Akureyri




