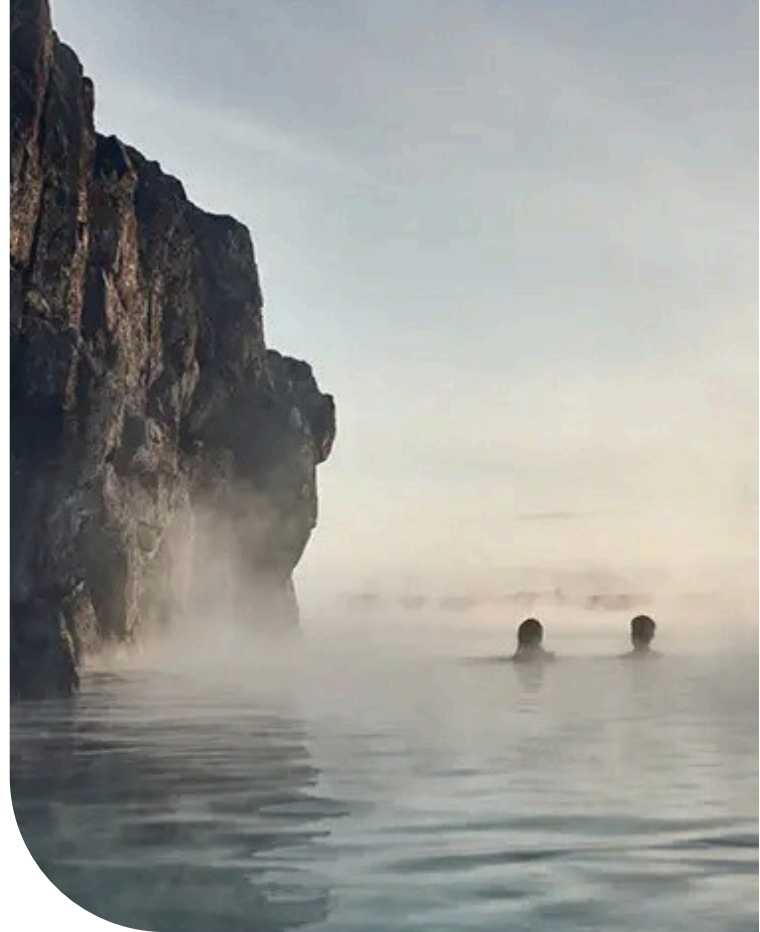

Journey Overview

This experience is for travelers seeking a balance of must-see spots, hidden gems, local culture, and culinary delights.

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Journey Itinerary



First Taste of Iceland: Reykjavik

Day 1: Arrival, Sky Lagoon & Northern Lights


Upon arrival at Keflavík International Airport, you are transferred to your hotel in central Reykjavik. After time to settle in, we head to Sky Lagoon for a geothermal bathing experience overlooking the North Atlantic, following the spa's signature ritual of warm pools, steam, and cold immersion. This evening, conditions permitting, we will keep an eye on the skies for your first opportunity to witness the Northern Lights. We then gather for a welcome dinner, meeting your local host and fellow travelers before the journey begins in full.

Day 2: Reykjavik Highlights & Perlan Experience


Today introduces you to Iceland through its capital. We explore Reykjavik by vehicle and on foot, visiting Hallgrímskirkja Church, Harpa Concert Hall, the harbor, and key cultural sites. Along the way, you gain insight into Iceland's history, independence, and contemporary life. Later, we visit Perlan, where interactive exhibits explain glaciers, volcanoes, and geothermal forces that shape the country. From the observation deck, panoramic views stretch across the city, sea, and mountains, providing context for the landscapes you will encounter throughout the week.

Golden Circle, Hidden Depths

Day 3: West Iceland: Hraunfossar & Lava Cave

We depart Reykjavik and travel into West Iceland, where geology becomes tangible. At Hraunfossar, clear streams flow from beneath lava fields into a turquoise river, offering a striking introduction to Iceland's volcanic terrain. We then descend into Víðgelmir lava cave for a guided walk through vast underground chambers formed by ancient eruptions. As we continue toward our new base near the Golden Circle region, rural landscapes unfold around us. This repositioning sets the stage for deeper exploration in the days ahead.

Day 4: Golden Circle, Greenhouse & Laugarás Lagoon

Today, we explore Iceland's celebrated Golden Circle route. At Þingvellir National Park, you stand between two tectonic plates while learning about Iceland's early parliament and national identity. We continue to Gullfoss waterfall and the Geysir geothermal area, where Strokkur erupts at regular intervals. Lunch is served inside the geothermal greenhouses of Friðheimar, followed by an introduction to Icelandic horses. The afternoon concludes at Laugarás Lagoon, where warm geothermal waters provide a welcome pause before returning to the hotel.

South Coast Scenes & Reykjavik Return

Day 5: Icelandic Wool Tradition & Seljalandsfoss Waterfall


This morning, we visit Uppspuni Mini Mill, a family-run workshop producing 100% Icelandic yarn, where you see firsthand how local wool is processed and preserved as part of national tradition. We then continue south to Seljalandsfoss waterfall, where a walking path (conditions permitting) allows you to step behind the cascading water. The drive along Iceland's South Coast reveals open farmland and distant glaciers as we relocate to our new base. With darker skies in this region, tonight offers another strong opportunity to search for the Northern Lights.

Day 6: South Coast, Reynisfjara & Katla Ice Cave

Today is dedicated to the dramatic South Coast. We stop at additional waterfalls before reaching Reynisfjara, the black-sand beach known for its basalt columns and powerful Atlantic waves. The highlight is a guided excursion into the Katla Ice Cave, where layers of blue and black ice reveal the interaction between glacier and volcano. Conditions and safety determine access, but, when possible, this is a rare and memorable experience. In the evening, we gather for a closing dinner to mark the conclusion of our shared journey.

Day 7: Reykjavik Return & Departure

After breakfast, we drive back to Reykjavik. Upon arrival, you have free time for independent exploration: whether revisiting a favorite landmark, browsing Icelandic design shops, or enjoying a final coffee in the city center. This final stretch allows you to absorb the atmosphere of the capital with a fresh perspective. At the designated time, we transfer to Keflavík International Airport for departing flights, concluding a week that has combined geothermal landscapes, coastal drama, and multiple opportunities to witness the Northern Lights.

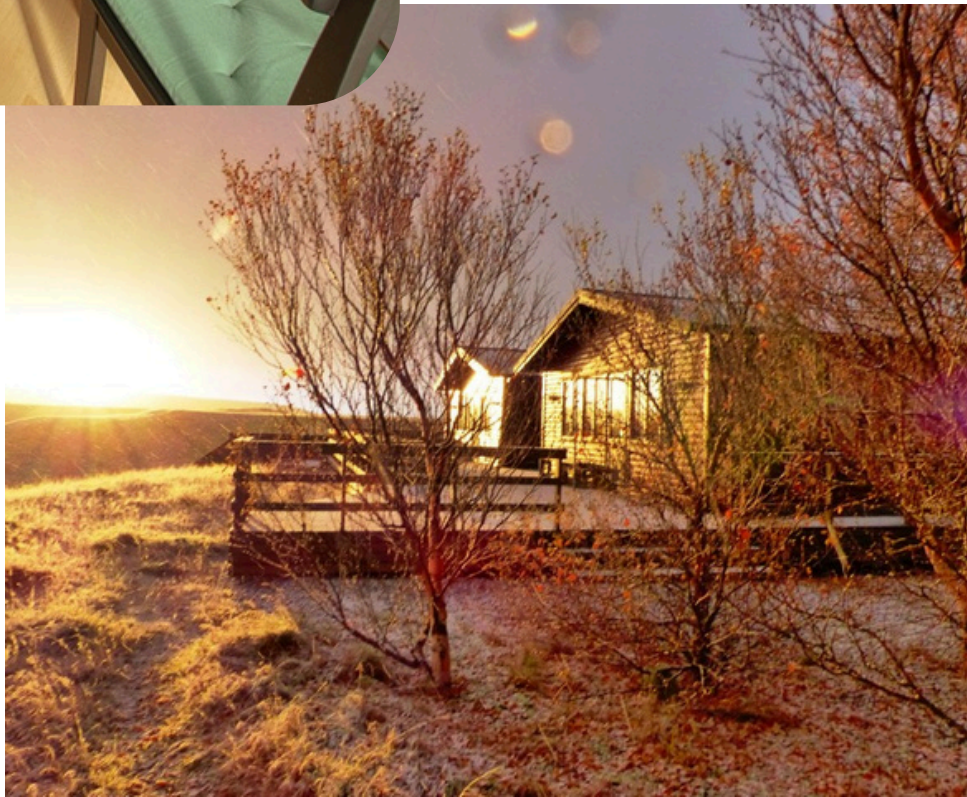
