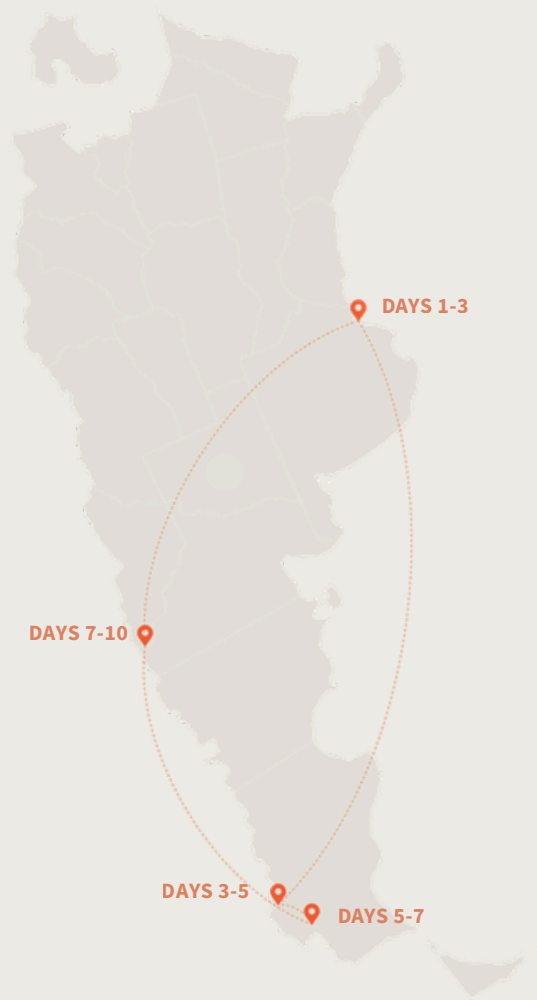

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Journey Itinerary

Day 1: Buenos Aires Arrival and Recoleta Welcome

You arrive in Buenos Aires and are transferred to the hotel, where your Local Host and fellow travelers are waiting. After settling in, the group sets off on a walking tour of Recoleta — one of the city's most elegant neighborhoods. You wander beneath jacaranda trees, marvel at the ornate tombs of the famous cemetery, and step inside the serene Basílica Nuestra Señora del Pilar. The day closes with a welcome dinner where empanadas are made, mate is sipped, and the journey begins in earnest.

Day 2: Buenos Aires City Tour and Tango Show

Your Local Host leads the group through Buenos Aires' most compelling neighborhoods — the cobblestone streets and antique markets of San Telmo, the sleek waterfront of Puerto Madero, and the tree-lined boulevards of Palermo. You pause at the Obelisco on Avenida 9 de Julio, one of the widest avenues in the world, to take in the scale of the city. The afternoon is free to explore independently. In the evening, the group attends one of the most traditional tango houses in Buenos Aires — intimate, precise, and unforgettable.

Day 3: Flight to Patagonia and Scenic Drive to El Chaltén

A morning flight takes the group to El Calafate, where a scenic drive along Route 40 begins the journey into Patagonia. The landscape shifts dramatically — endless steppe, shimmering lakes, and distant peaks that grow taller as the road heads north. Your Local Host shares stories of early pioneers and local wildlife along the way. A stop at a traditional estancia for lunch offers a first taste of Patagonian hospitality. As El Chaltén comes into view, Mount Fitz Roy rises on the horizon — one of the most dramatic mountain silhouettes on earth. Dinner is served at the hotel, one of the finest restaurants in El Chaltén.

Day 4: Estancia Visit, Waterfall Hike, and Casa Madsen

Late morning, the group heads to Estancia Bonanza — a working Patagonian farm nestled in a pristine valley with sweeping views of the surrounding mountains. After a homemade country-style lunch, a gentle hike leads to Chorrillo del Salto, a cascading waterfall framed by lenga beech trees, with views across the Fitz Roy range on the return. The day finishes with a visit to Casa Madsen, where the story of one of El Chaltén's first settlers brings the region's frontier history vividly to life.

Day 5: Petrified Forest, 4x4 to Cerro Huyliche, and Estancia Dinner

The group departs El Chaltén heading south toward El Calafate, stopping at the La Leona Petrified Forest — an eerie and fascinating landscape where ancient fossilized trees and bones emerge from the Patagonian wind. After checking into the hotel, the afternoon takes a dramatic turn: a 4x4 ascent up Cerro Huyliche reveals astonishing views over Lago Argentino and the Andean peaks. The group descends through wind-sculpted rock formations to Estancia Huyliche for dinner — remote, warm, and genuinely memorable.

Day 6: Perito Moreno Glacier

Today is devoted entirely to the crown jewel of Patagonia. The drive to Los Glaciares National Park builds steady anticipation before the glacier itself comes into view — a vast wall of blue ice advancing into Lago Argentino, groaning and cracking as chunks calve into the water below. Travelers have three options for experiencing the glacier up close: a scenic boat ride along its face, a serene blue safari, or a guided mini-trek across the ice itself. The group reunites at the walkway balconies, trading stories in thoughtful silence on the drive back.

Day 7: Bariloche, Circuito Chico, Chocolate Workshop, and Brewery

A short flight north brings the group to Bariloche, and the contrast with Patagonia's sparse steppe is immediate — blue lakes, pine-forested slopes, and snow-dusted Andean peaks in every direction. The Circuito Chico scenic drive reveals the best of the landscape before a hands-on session with a local chocolatier, a genuine Bariloche tradition. The afternoon finishes at a craft brewery overlooking Lake Moreno — locally brewed beer, freshly made empanadas, and a view that earns a long, unhurried pause. Dinner is served at Llao Llao's elegant restaurant, the perfect end to a long and rewarding day.

Day 8: Lake Nahuel Huapi Cruise and Arrayanes Forest

The group sets sail across Lake Nahuel Huapi, bound for Victoria Island — a place of quiet, exceptional beauty where trails wind through ancient groves of pine and cypress to panoramic lookouts and white-sand beaches. The cruise continues to the Arrayanes Forest, one of the rarest woodland environments in the world, where cinnamon-colored trunks twist into an almost dreamlike canopy. It's a day of unhurried discovery on the water and through the trees, ending back at Llao Llao in the cool Patagonian afternoon.

Day 9: Open Day and Farewell Dinner with a Local Chef

The day is yours — golf on one of South America's most scenic courses, fishing on the lake, or a trip into Villa la Angostura to explore at your own pace. The evening brings the program to a memorable close. The group is welcomed into the home of a local chef and musician, gathering around an outdoor grill as traditional Patagonian dishes are prepared over an open fire. There is laughter, live music, and the particular warmth of a final night shared with people who have traveled far together.

Day 10: Return to Buenos Aires and Departure

After breakfast at Llao Llao, the group transfers to Bariloche Airport for the flight back to Buenos Aires. From there, onward flights home or an independent extension of the journey. Ten days, four destinations, one country that covers an astonishing range — from a world capital's energy to the most remote landscapes on earth.

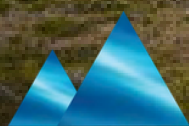
