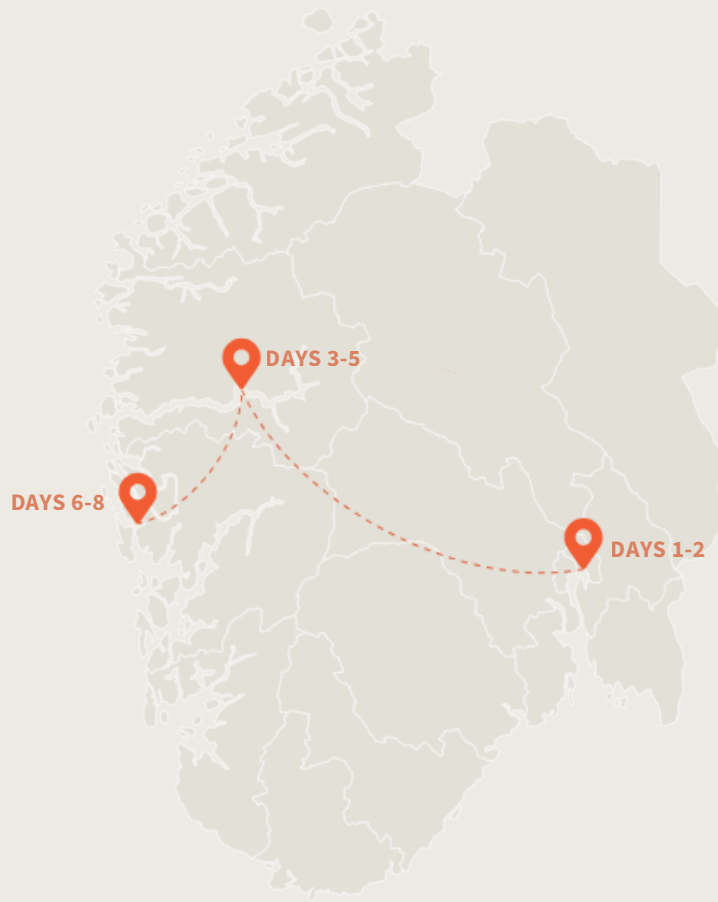

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Journey Itinerary

Day 1: Oslo Arrival and Fjord Dinner Cruise

Your Local Host meets you at the hotel in the early evening for introductions before the group boards a boat for a dinner cruise on the Oslofjord. The cruise passes forested islands and historic waterfront landmarks, a genuinely fine way to arrive in Norway. By the time you return to the hotel, you've already seen the country from the water, shared a meal with your fellow travelers, and set the tone for what lies ahead.

Day 2: Oslo Archipelago Island Hopping

A boat tour through the Oslo Archipelago takes you to the scattered islands, rocky shores, and forested coves that sit just minutes from the capital, revealing a natural side of Oslo that most visitors never reach. There's time to step ashore and take in the surroundings before returning to the city. The afternoon and evening are free to explore independently: the waterfront, the museums, the neighborhoods, or wherever your curiosity takes you.

Day 3: Bergen Railway, Flåmsbana, and Ferry to Balestrand

This is a genuinely exceptional travel day. You board the Bergen Railway from Oslo to Myrdal, then transfer to the Flåmsbana for the steep, dramatic descent to Flåm – one of the world’s great train journeys, threading past waterfalls and deep mountain gorges. From Flåm, an express ferry carries you along the Sognefjord to Balestrand, a small village of real character on the fjord’s edge. Your luggage travels independently to the hotel, for added comfort and convenience. Dinner and your first night at the historic Kviknes Hotel await.

Day 4: Balestrand Tour, Cider Tasting, and RIB Boat Excursion

A local guide leads a walking tour of Balestrand, covering its Viking heritage, distinctive architecture, and the history of this fjordside community. The afternoon brings two back-to-back highlights: first, a RIB speedboat ride across the Sognefjord, where the scale of the surrounding mountains and the depth of the water make a strong impression. Then, a cider tasting session featuring locally produced ciders paired with regional snacks and chocolates. It’s a genuine taste of the area, and a fine way to end the day before dinner in Balestrand.

Day 5: Hiking, Biking, and Sauna in Balestrand

A more open day built around the landscape. A light morning hike reveals broader views across the fjord and the valley. Bicycles are available for those who want to explore the roads and scenery at their own pace, and kayaking is also possible. Later, the group gathers for a sauna, a deeply Norwegian experience, and a satisfying and relaxing way to end an active day outdoors. Dinner and a final night at the Kviknes Hotel close out what has been two excellent days in the Sognefjord region.

Day 6: Fjærland, Bøyabreen Glacier, and Ferry to Bergen

The day begins with a boat excursion from Balestrand deep into the Fjærlandsfjord, one of the most sheltered and striking branches of the Sognefjord. In Fjærland, you visit the Norwegian Glacier Museum, an interactive exhibition on glaciers and climate, before continuing up to Bøyabreen, an arm of the vast Jostedalbreen glacier, where the ice descends visibly over the mountainside. After returning to the pier, you board the express ferry from Balestrand to Bergen, the scenery continuing to deliver on the way out. Overnight in Bergen.

Day 7: Bergen Tour, Fløibanen Funicular, and Mount Ulriken

Bergen is best explored on foot. The morning takes you through Bryggen, the UNESCO-listed wharf district whose colorful wooden buildings date to the city's era as a Hanseatic trading hub. The Fløibanen funicular carries you to the top of Mount Fløyen for wide views over the rooftops, the harbor, and the fjords beyond. A visit to Mount Ulriken adds a second, higher vantage point over the city. The journey ends as it should: together, over a farewell dinner in Bergen.
