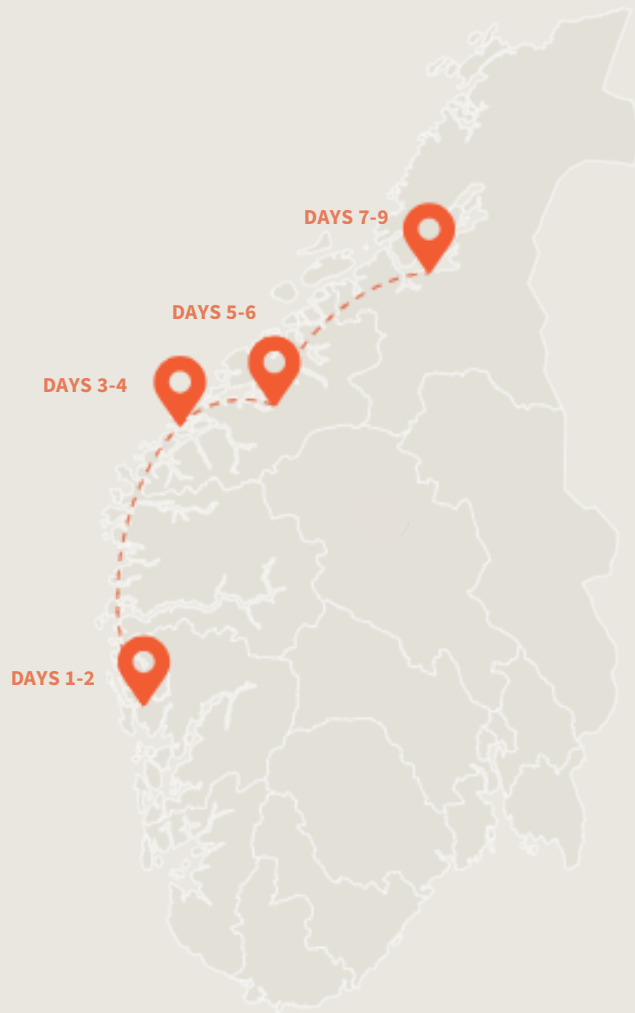

This nine-day journey follows the western and central coast from Bergen to Trondheim — by plane, ferry, gondola, luxury coach, and train — moving through fishing villages, Viking islands, Art Nouveau architecture, and one of the world's great fjords. It covers the landscapes Norway is famous for and the places most tours never reach. It ends in Trondheim, Norway's technology capital and one of its most compelling cities, at one of the finest hotels in Scandinavia. Maritime life, open coastline, and a country that keeps surprising you. The coast is the road. The journey is the destination.

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Journey Itinerary

Day 1: Bergen Arrival and Welcome Dinner

Your Local Host meets you at the hotel in Bergen for introductions before the group gathers for a welcome dinner in the city. Bergen is one of Norway's most characterful cities – a compact harbor town framed by seven mountains, with a UNESCO-listed wharf and a maritime energy that sets the tone for everything that follows. It's a fine place to begin nine days on the Norwegian coast, and by the end of the evening, the journey has already started to feel real.

Day 2: Bergen City Tour, Fløibanen Funicular, and Mount Ulriken

A full morning exploring Bergen on foot with your Local Host. The tour takes you through Bryggen, the UNESCO-listed wharf district whose colorful wooden buildings date to the city's Hanseatic trading era. The Fløibanen funicular carries you to the top of Mount Fløyen for sweeping views over the harbor and surrounding peaks. A gondola ride then takes you to the summit of Mount Ulriken – the highest of Bergen's seven mountains – for a second, even wider vantage point over the city. The afternoon and evening are free to explore independently.

Day 3: Flight to Ålesund and City Tour

A short, scenic flight up the coast brings you to Ålesund and the views from the window alone are worth the journey. One of the most visually distinctive cities in Norway, Ålesund was rebuilt almost entirely in Art Nouveau style after a fire in 1904, and it sits across a cluster of islands and peninsulas with the sea pressing in on all sides. You check into historic Hotel Brosundet, set directly on the waterfront, and spend the afternoon exploring the city's streets and harbor with your Local Host. Dinner at the refined Apotekergata No 5 rounds out the evening.

Day 4: Full-Day Geirangerfjord Cruise

A full day on one of the most celebrated stretches of water in the world. The Geirangerfjord – a UNESCO World Heritage Site – draws you in past the Seven Sisters waterfall, sheer cliff faces, and abandoned mountain farms clinging to ledges high above the water. The cruise includes time ashore in Geiranger village, where you can wander the waterfront, explore at your own pace, and take in the extraordinary surroundings from land as well as water. The group returns to Ålesund in the late afternoon.

Day 5: Ålesund Archipelago Tour, then Transfer to Åndalsnes

The morning is spent island-hopping around Ålesund with your Local Host. Giske Island – birthplace of Viking chieftain Rollo – offers a striking 12th-century marble church and Bronze Age history. The fishing village of Alnes on Godøy Island follows, with its famous lighthouse and Atlantic views. Back in Ålesund, a short walk (or drive) leads to the Aksla viewpoint for panoramic views over the city and surrounding fjords, before descending 418 steps to the harbor. A luxury coach then transfers the group to Åndalsnes for dinner.

Day 6: Trollstigen Mountain Road and Romsdalen Gondola

A day of dramatic Norwegian scenery in two very different forms. The morning takes you on a tour along Trollstigen, the legendary serpentine mountain road that climbs through eleven hairpin bends above a cascade of waterfalls, aboard a luxury coach. In the afternoon, the Romsdalen Gondola lifts you above the valley for panoramic views across the fjord and the surrounding peaks, followed by lunch at the scenic Eggen Café. The evening is free in Åndalsnes.

Day 7: Rauma Railway to Dombås, then on to Trondheim

One of the great train journeys of Norway begins this morning in Åndalsnes. The Rauma Railway climbs through the Romsdalen valley – past waterfalls, granite walls, and the iconic Trollveggen cliff face – to Dombås, where you connect onward to Trondheim. The scenery makes every kilometer count. You arrive in Trondheim, Norway's third-largest city, and check into the legendary Hotel Britannia, a five-star landmark that has been the city's finest address since 1870, recently restored to an exceptional standard. The evening is free to begin exploring on your own terms. Dinner in the city.

Day 8: Trondheim Waterfront Tour and Countryside Bike Ride

Trondheim rewards exploration, and today you do it two ways. The morning brings a guided waterfront tour of the city: taking in the Nidaros Cathedral, the Old Town Bridge, and the colorful wooden warehouses lining the Nidelva River. In the afternoon, a bike excursion into the Trondheim countryside offers a different perspective: rolling farmland, quiet roads, and the kind of unhurried pace that defines this program. The journey ends as it should – together, over a farewell dinner in Trondheim.

Day 9: Breakfast and Departure from Trondheim

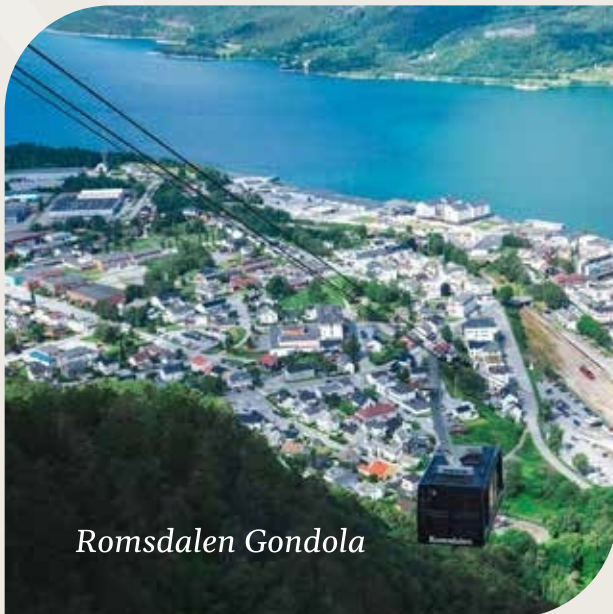
