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Journey Itinerary

Day 1: Stockholm Arrival and Welcome Dinner

You arrive in Stockholm and transfer to the hotel, where your Swedish Local Host and fellow travelers are waiting. After introductions, the evening is yours to settle into one of Europe's most beautiful capital cities, built across fourteen islands where Lake Mälaren meets the Baltic Sea. The group gathers for a welcome dinner, the first shared meal of what promises to be an exceptional fifteen days across three countries.

Day 2: Stockholm City Tour and Vasa Museum

Your Swedish Local Host leads a comprehensive walking tour of Stockholm, moving through the city's neighborhoods, landmarks, and waterways with the depth and enthusiasm that only a true local can bring. The tour includes a visit to the Vasa Museum, home to a magnificently preserved 17th-century warship that sank on its maiden voyage – one of the most extraordinary museum experiences in Scandinavia. The afternoon is yours to explore at your own pace.

Day 3: Open Day in Stockholm

Today belongs entirely to you. Stockholm rewards independent exploration, whether you wander Gamla Stan's medieval lanes, browse the design shops of Södermalm, or find a waterfront café and watch the city go by. For those who want something more active, an optional kayaking excursion through the Stockholm Archipelago is available – a genuinely memorable way to experience the city from the water. Your Swedish Local Host is available throughout for recommendations and assistance.

Day 4: Scenic Train to Copenhagen

Your Swedish Local Host accompanies the group to the station and sees you off before the six-hour first-class train journey south through the Swedish and Danish countryside. It's a beautifully unhurried way to cross between countries, and by the time you roll into Copenhagen, the change of scenery has already shifted the mood. Your Danish Local Host meets the group at the station and takes you to the hotel. The evening begins with a welcome dinner – your first taste of Copenhagen and of Denmark.

Day 5: Copenhagen City Tour and Canal Cruise

Your Danish Local Host leads a comprehensive walking tour of Copenhagen - Nyhavn's colorful waterfront, Amalienborg Palace, the Little Mermaid, Christiansborg – before the group boards a canal cruise for a different perspective on the city. From the water, Copenhagen's architecture and history open up in ways the streets alone can't reveal. It's a full and satisfying introduction to one of Europe's most livable and distinctive capitals.

Day 6: Open Day in Copenhagen

Copenhagen is made for independent exploration, and today you have the full freedom to do exactly that, equipped with a Copenhagen Card giving you access to public transport and a wide range of museums and attractions. Tivoli Gardens, the National Museum, the Round Tower, Strøget – the city offers enough for several days. Your Danish Local Host is on hand for guidance, but the day is yours to follow your own curiosity.

Day 7: Scenic Train to Aarhus

A three-hour first-class train ride carries the group north through the Danish countryside to Aarhus, Denmark's second city and one of the most underrated stops in Scandinavia. Younger, more relaxed, and more local-feeling than Copenhagen, Aarhus has a vibrant cultural scene, a compact and walkable city center, and a warmth that tends to surprise first-time visitors. The group settles in over dinner, with a full day of the city ahead tomorrow.

Day 8: Aarhus City Tour and Cream Puff Workshop

Your Danish Local Host leads a comprehensive morning tour of Aarhus – the Latin Quarter, the ARoS Art Museum with its iconic rainbow panorama, the Old Town open-air museum, and the waterfront. In the afternoon, the group heads to a hands-on cream puff workshop with master chocolatier Nicolai, a genuinely enjoyable and delicious session that goes well beyond baking, covering chocolate molding, foam techniques, and the finishing touches that turn a simple pastry into something worth talking about.

Day 9: Aalborg Tour, then Overnight Ferry to Bergen

A luxury coach takes the group north to Hirtshals, with a stop in Aalborg, a city whose medieval architecture, waterfront, and Viking heritage reward a few hours of exploration with your Local Host. In the evening, your Danish Local Host sees the group off at the port before you board the overnight ferry to Bergen. Dinner is served on board as the ship heads out into the North Sea, and Norway begins to feel close.

Day 10: Arrival in Bergen and Welcome to Norway

The ferry docks in Bergen in the late morning, where your Norwegian Local Host is waiting at the port to welcome the group and transfer you to the hotel. Bergen announces itself immediately – a compact harbor city framed by seven mountains, with a UNESCO-listed wharf and a maritime character that sets it apart from anywhere else in Norway. The group gathers in the evening for a welcome dinner, the first of several nights in Norway.

Day 11: Bergen City Tour, Fløibanen Funicular, and Mt. Ulriken

Your Norwegian Local Host leads a comprehensive exploration of Bergen – through the Bryggen wharf district, past fish markets and historic alleyways, and up the Fløibanen funicular to the top of Mount Fløyen for sweeping views over the city, the harbor, and the fjords beyond. A gondola ride to the summit of Mount Ulriken – the highest of Bergen's seven mountains – adds a second, higher vantage point and a perspective on the city that stays with you. The afternoon is free to explore independently.

Day 12: Ferry to Balestrand, Cider Tasting, and Kviknes Hotel

Your luggage travels separately to Oslo today – a logistical touch that makes the day considerably more comfortable. The group transfers to the terminal and boards an express ferry into the Sognefjord, arriving in Balestrand, a small and strikingly beautiful village on the fjord's edge. The afternoon includes a cider tasting session at Ciderhuset, featuring locally produced ciders paired with regional snacks. Dinner at the historic Kviknes Hotel, perched above the Sognefjord, ends a day that covers a remarkable amount of ground.

Day 13: Flåmsbana, Bergen Railway, and Arrival in Oslo

Today is one of the great travel days of the program. The group boards a ferry from Balestrand to Flåm, then transfers to the Flåmsbana – one of the world's steepest and most celebrated railway journeys, threading through waterfalls and mountain gorges on its descent to the valley floor. From Myrdal, the Bergen Railway carries you onward to Oslo. By the time you arrive in Norway's capital, you've crossed some of the most spectacular terrain in Europe entirely by boat and train.

Day 14: Oslo Tour, Vigeland Park, Bygdøy, and Farewell Dinner

Your Norwegian Local Host leads a full-day tour of Oslo – Vigeland Park, with its extraordinary collection of sculptures by Gustav Vigeland, the museums and historic ships of the Bygdøy peninsula, and the city's waterfront and neighborhoods. The Oslo Pass provides access to a wide range of attractions throughout the day. In the evening, the group gathers for a farewell dinner – fifteen days, three countries, three Local Hosts, and a journey that covered Scandinavia from the Baltic to the North Sea.
