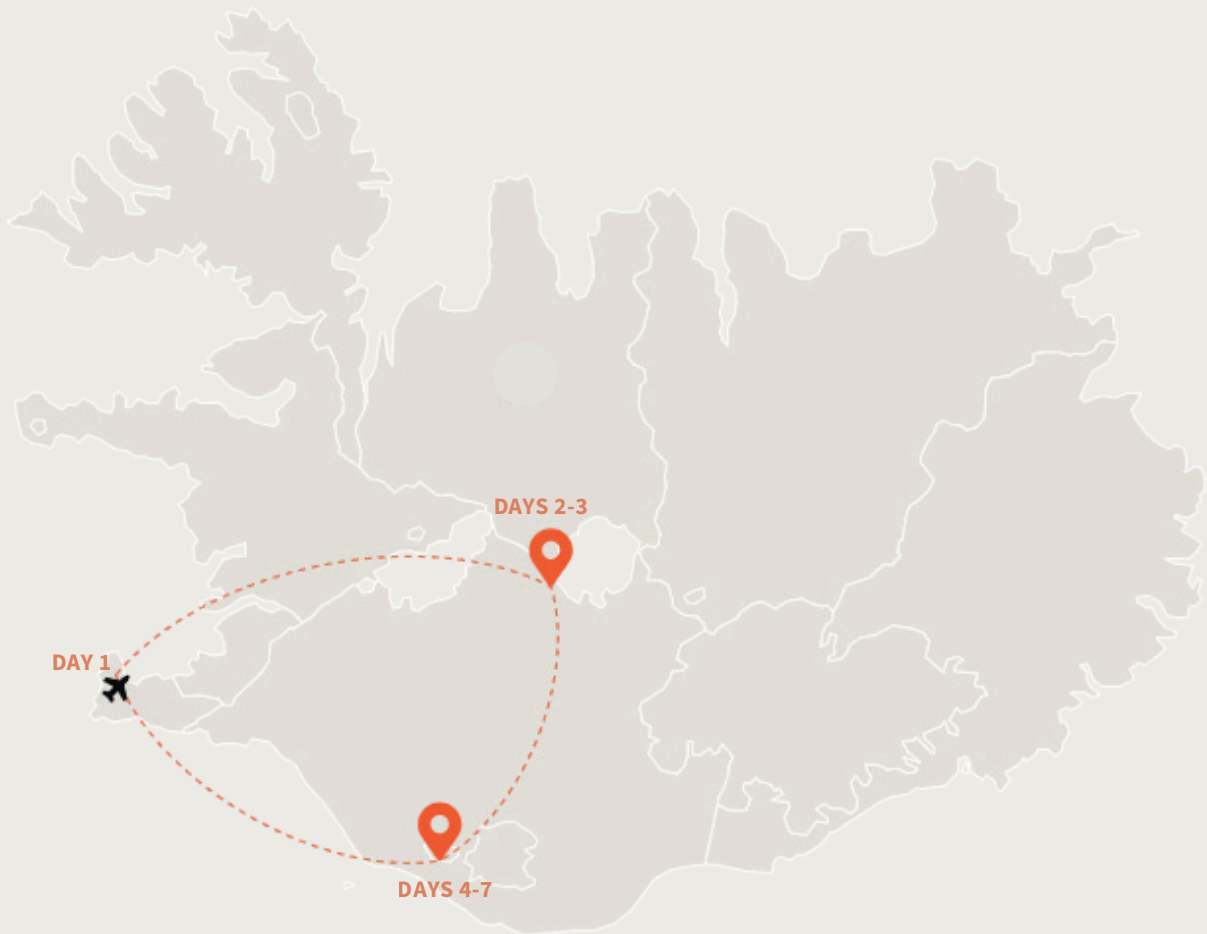

Continue along the South Coast to waterfalls, black-sand beaches, and dramatic coastal scenery, then cross to the volcanic Westman Islands for a deeper perspective on Iceland's raw forces. Each day blends active discovery with unhurried moments, while evenings bring authentic Icelandic gastronomy and carefully selected luxurious retreats. The result is a balanced rhythm of exploration and comfort, designed to experience Iceland's most compelling landscapes without feeling rushed.

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Journey Itinerary

Day 1: Arrival in Reykjavik and Welcome Evening

Upon arrival at Keflavík International Airport, transfer to your hotel in Reykjavik. After time to settle in, meet your local host and fellow travelers for an introduction to the journey ahead. This relaxed gathering sets the tone and provides practical orientation. The remainder of the evening is devoted to the kick-off dinner, offering a first taste of Icelandic hospitality and an opportunity to connect with the group.

Day 2: Reykjavik Exploration and Highlands Transfer via Geysir

Begin with a comprehensive exploration of Reykjavik, combining a panoramic drive with time on foot to experience key landmarks and neighborhoods. Depart the capital toward the Golden Circle, stopping at the Geysir geothermal area, where erupting hot springs demonstrate Iceland's volcanic energy. Continue into the Icelandic Highlands, a remote and rarely visited region. Arrive at your luxury base surrounded by dramatic landscapes. Time is available to relax in the geothermal Highland Baths before dinner. The remote location offers excellent conditions for viewing the Northern Lights if skies are clear (September through March only).

Day 3: Highlands Hiking and Light Adventure

The morning is open for independent exploration and hiking around the Highland Base area, known for its geothermal terrain and scenic trails. In the afternoon, experience a guided buggy excursion across the rugged landscape, followed by a guided e-mountain biking activity designed to explore areas not accessible by regular vehicles. These light adventures provide a close-up experience of Iceland's interior wilderness. Return to the hotel with time to relax once again in the geothermal Highland Baths.

Day 4: Þingvellir, Gullfoss, and South Coast to Skálakot

Depart the Highlands following the Golden Circle route. Visit Þingvellir National Park, where tectonic plates visibly separate, and continue to Gullfoss, one of Iceland's most impressive waterfalls. Stop at Friðheimar greenhouse for lunch and a tour of the tomato farm, including the opportunity to observe Icelandic horses. Continue toward Iceland's South Coast, transitioning from highland terrain to farmland and coastal scenery. Arrive at Skálakot Manor, a refined countryside retreat serving as your base for the next portion of the journey.

Day 5: South Coast Waterfalls and Reynisfjara Black Sand Beach

Travel along Iceland's South Coast, visiting a sequence of iconic waterfalls shaped by glacial rivers. Continue to Reynisfjara black-sand beach, known for its basalt columns, Atlantic waves, and dramatic coastal cliffs. The day emphasizes Iceland's volcanic shoreline and glacial landscapes. Return to Skálakot Manor in the late afternoon. With minimal light pollution in this rural setting, conditions may allow for Northern Lights viewing during the evening, depending on weather and solar activity.

Day 6: Westman Islands Exploration

Drive to the ferry terminal and cross to the Westman Islands archipelago. Explore this volcanic island group on a guided tour, including views of lava formations from the 1973 eruption. Visit the Eldheimar Museum, where preserved homes and artifacts document the eruption's impact. Continue to a puffin sanctuary and coastal viewpoints showcasing the dramatic cliffs and seabird colonies. After a closing dinner in the islands, return by ferry to the mainland and back to Skálakot for the final night.

Day 7: Return to Reykjavik and Departure

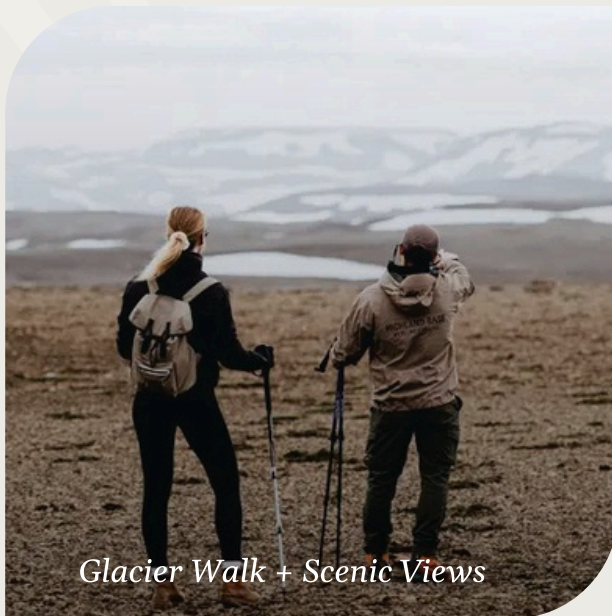
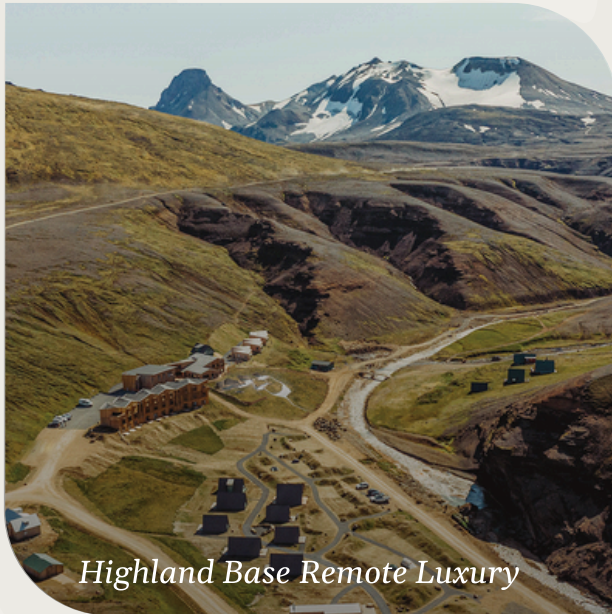
After breakfast, depart Skálakot and return to Reykjavik. Upon arrival, enjoy free time for independent sightseeing, shopping, or a final walk through the city's central areas. This open period allows flexibility depending on flight schedules. Later, transfer to Keflavík International Airport for departure, concluding the journey.
