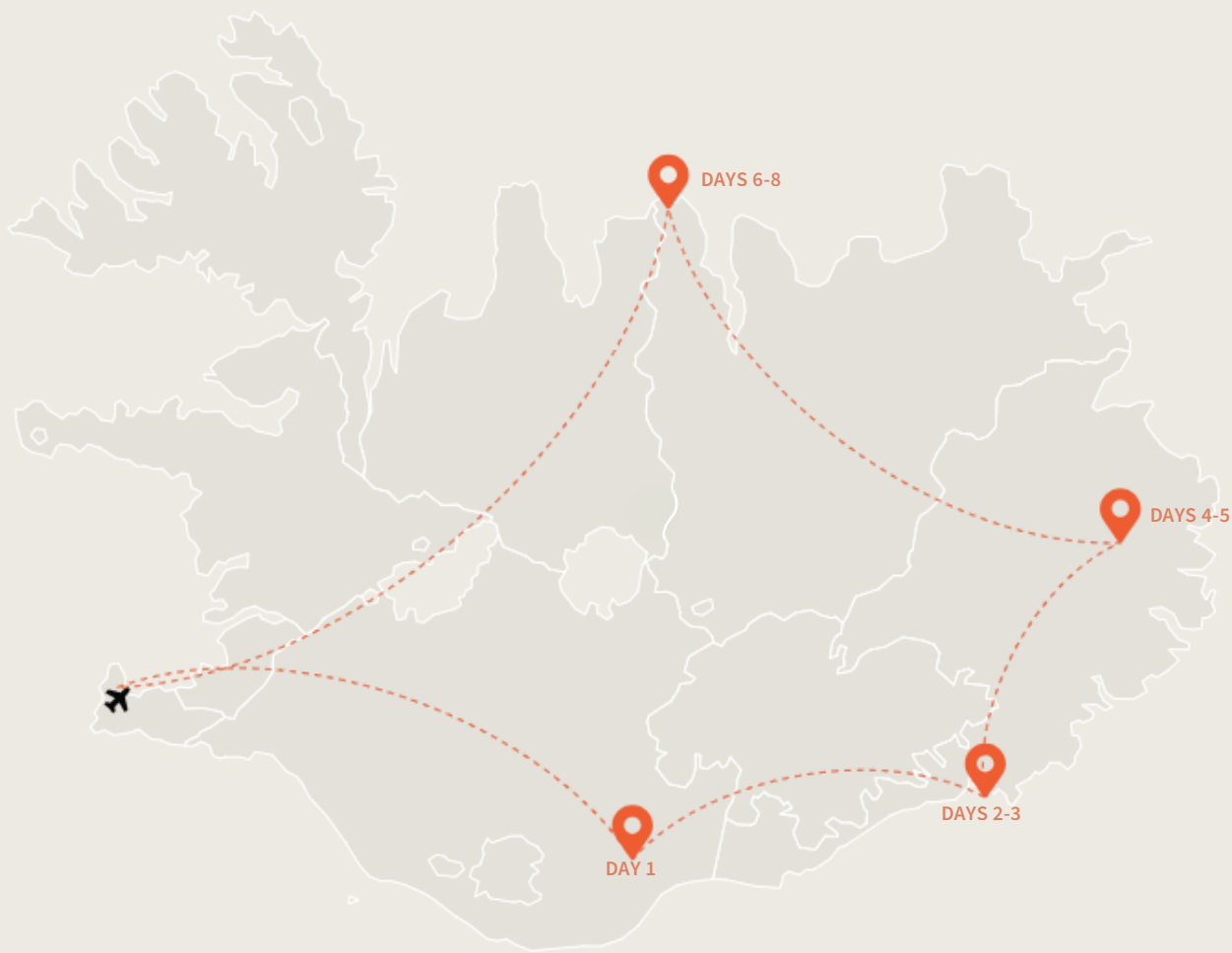

Eight days through the parts of Iceland that Icelanders keep for themselves — open landscapes, a brewery in a converted fish factory, and a country that reveals itself slowly to those willing to go looking.

Journey Itinerary

Day 1: South Coast Scenic Drive and Welcome Dinner

Your Local Host meets the group in Reykjavik before departing south along Iceland's dramatic coastline. The drive takes in two of Iceland's most spectacular waterfalls — including one you can walk behind — before reaching Reynisfjara's black sand beach and the lonely white church perched above the village of Vík. The day ends at a winding basalt canyon carved by a glacial river, one of those landscapes that makes you stop and simply look. A welcome dinner at the hotel closes an exceptional first day.

Day 2: Glacier Lagoon, Diamond Beach, and Höfn Food Tour

The morning brings one of Iceland's most extraordinary experiences: a Zodiac boat tour through Jökulsárlón glacier lagoon, weaving between icebergs that drift silently toward the sea. Just across the road, Diamond Beach lives up to its name — ice fragments scattered across black sand, glittering in the light. After checking into the hotel in Höfn, a local guide leads a walking tour of the town, ending with a food tasting at the harbor — Iceland's finest langoustine, freshly prepared in the small fishing town that is famous for it.

Day 3: Vatnaçökull National Park

Today is devoted to Europe's largest glacier and the remarkable landscape it has shaped around it. A guided exploration of Vatnaçökull National Park takes you along outlet glaciers, past glacial lagoons, and into terrain that most visitors never reach — unhurried, off the beaten path, and genuinely extraordinary. The scale of the ice and the silence of the landscape are the experience. The evening brings dinner in Höfn, with a second night at the hotel.

Day 4: Volcanic Coastline, Fishing Village, and Organic Farm Lunch

The drive east begins at a peninsula where black volcanic dunes stretch beneath the sharp, almost impossibly dramatic peaks of Vestrahorn — one of Iceland's great landscapes, and one that most visitors never reach. The route continues to a small coastal village with an unhurried pace, public sculptures, and sea views that invite a slow wander. Lunch is at a working organic farm where a buffet of fresh, homemade Icelandic food is followed by a guided tour of the property. By late afternoon, the group arrives at the hotel near Egillstaðir, surrounded by forest and fjords.

Day 5: Stuðlagil Canyon and Seyðisfjörður

The morning takes the group to Stuðlagil — a basalt canyon of extraordinary beauty, where perfectly geometric columns of rock frame a vivid blue-green glacial river far below. The walk in is easy and flat, and the payoff is remarkable. In the afternoon, the road climbs over a mountain pass and descends into Seyðisfjörður, a colorful fjordside village of 19th-century timber houses, street art, and a quiet creative energy that sets it apart from anywhere else in Iceland. Dinner back at the hotel ends the day.

Day 6: Geothermal Landscapes and Mývatn Nature Baths

The drive north pauses at a surreal geothermal field of boiling mud pots and sulfur vents, where the earth feels genuinely alive and the landscape resembles nothing so much as another planet. From there, the Mývatn Nature Baths offer a long, restorative soak in mineral-rich geothermal water with views across a lava-filled lake basin. The afternoon drive continues north through some of Iceland's most varied scenery, arriving at Siglo Hotel in Sigluðjörður — a beautifully restored harbor hotel at the end of a fjord in Iceland's far north.

Day 7: Sigluðjörður, Herring Museum, and Farewell Dinner

Sigluðjörður is one of Iceland's most rewarding small towns, and the morning is yours to explore — a hike up the trail above the fjord for sweeping views, or a visit to the award-winning Herring Era Museum, which documents the town's remarkable boom-and-bust fishing history with genuine depth and care. In the afternoon, the group takes a private tour and tasting at a craft brewery housed in a former fish factory on the harbor. A three-course farewell dinner at the hotel restaurant closes the journey in the right spirit.

Day 8: Akureyri and Departure Flight to Reykjavik

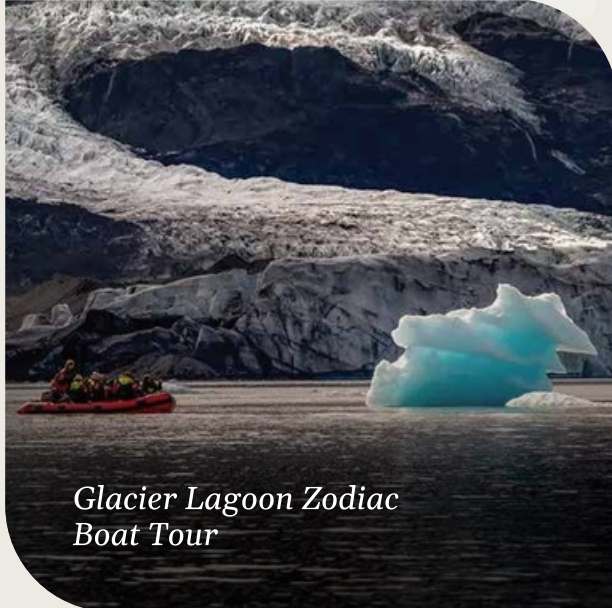
After breakfast, the group transfers to Akureyri — Iceland's second city and the capital of the north — for a visit before the short flight to Reykjavik's domestic airport. Akureyri rewards even a brief stop: a compact and characterful town with a botanical garden, a striking modern church, and a waterfront that punches well above its size. Eight days through a side of Iceland that most travelers never find. The memories, as it turns out, are very easy to keep.
